

Tots learn all about flora & fauna

The PDEA English Medium Primary School, Kharadi, organised a 'Flora and Fauna week' for the Upper KG class. The week of fun-filled learning helped the kids develop respect for the natural environment around them.

An array of modules were planned that included a virtual tour to the garden. They learnt about parts of a plant and types of plants. The medicinal value of herbs and other products like wood, paper, vegetable and fruit that we get from trees and herbs were highlights of this online module.

Children participated in all the activities enthusiastically. Sweta Gupta, the class teacher conducted the week's activity.

The first day they were given a brief introduction to 'Flora and Fauna'; next day they participated in 'nature art'. They made trees with different types of leaves and flowers; the third day, they learnt the difference between farm animals, pet animals, wild animals through pictorial online presentations. The children were dressed up as their favourite animals; Then there was a 'Chlorophyll filling activity' - where they learnt why leaves are green in colour.
